On 09/22/19 at approximately 0257 hours, officers responded to the 2700 block of Tongass Avenue for a report of a group of individuals causing a disturbance. Officers contacted Lowell Oposcolo, age 36, as one of the individuals. A record check showed Mr. Oposcolo to have valid conditions of release not to consume alcohol. Mr. Oposcolo was arrested for Violation of Conditions of Release. He was transported to the state jail and held on \$250.00 bail.

On 09/23/19 at approximately 2032 hours, officers were dispatched to a disturbance in the 300 block of Spruce St. Officers contacted Robert Lewis, age 49, who was arrested for Criminal Mischief in the 5th Degree and transported to the state jail where he was set to be released on his own recognizance.

Mr. Brown was not allowed in the apartment and he entered without permission. He was arrested for Trespass in the 1st Degree.
